



Definition

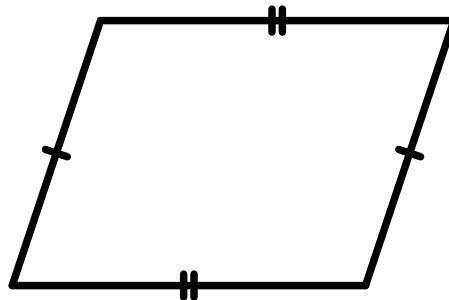
Two or more sides that have the same length.

In simple terms:

Sides that are equal in length.

Example:

In a parallelogram, opposite sides are congruent.



Important Note:

Congruent sides are marked with matching tick marks in diagrams to show they have equal length.
