




Parallelogram

Definition

A quadrilateral with both pairs of opposite sides parallel.

In simple terms:

A four-sided shape where both pairs of opposite sides run in the same direction.

Example:

Rectangle, rhombus, and square are all special types of parallelograms.

Important Notes:

- Opposite sides are parallel and congruent
- Opposite angles are congruent
- Consecutive angles are supplementary
- Diagonals bisect each other
