


Definition

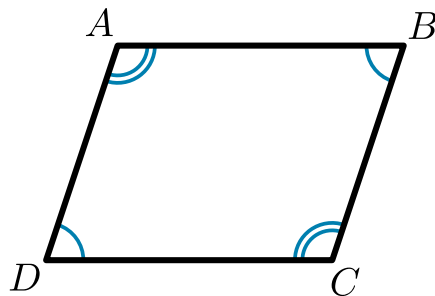
Two angles in a polygon that are across from each other and do not share a side.

In simple terms:

Angles that face each other.

Example:

In parallelogram $ABCD$, $\angle A$ and $\angle C$ are opposite angles. $\angle B$ and $\angle D$ are also opposite angles.



Important Note (Parallelograms):

In a parallelogram, opposite angles are congruent (they have equal measure).
