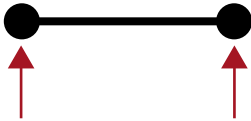
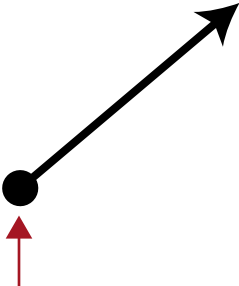
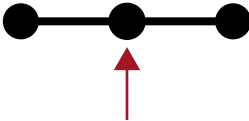

Definition

An **endpoint** is a **point that marks the end of a line segment or the start of a ray**.

- A **line segment** has **two endpoints**—one at each end.
- A **ray** has **one endpoint**, where it begins, and then it continues in one direction forever.

Endpoints are often used to name segments and rays. For example, segment AB has endpoints A and B .
