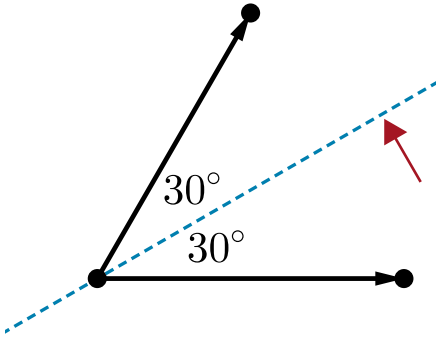
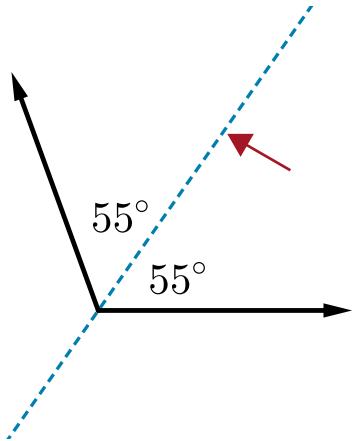
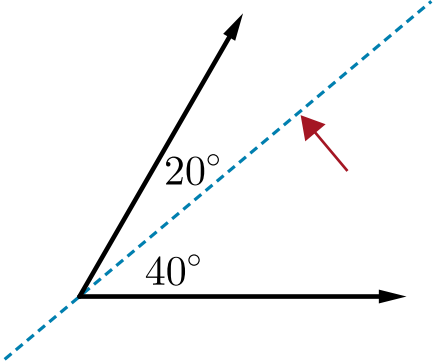

Definition

An **angle bisector** is a **ray or line that divides an angle into two equal parts**.

It starts at the angle's **vertex** and splits the angle into **two congruent (equal) angles**.
