
Glide Reflection

Definition

A glide reflection is a composition of two transformations: a translation followed by a reflection over a line parallel to the direction of the translation.

Key Points:

- It's a **rigid motion**, meaning it preserves **shape and size**.
- The reflection line must be **parallel** to the direction of the slide.
