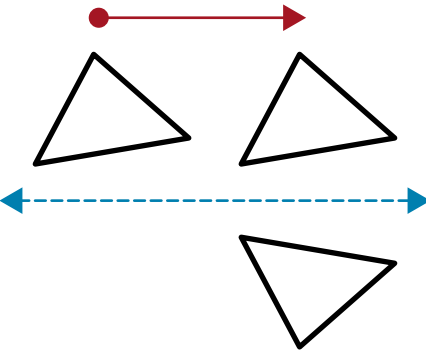
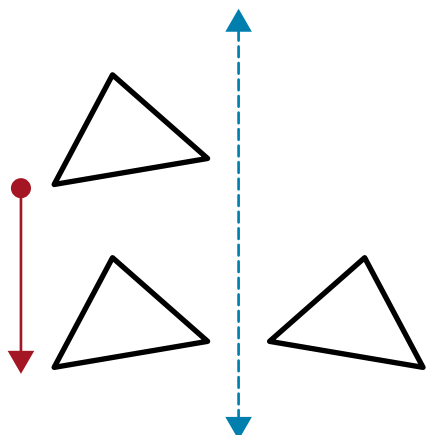
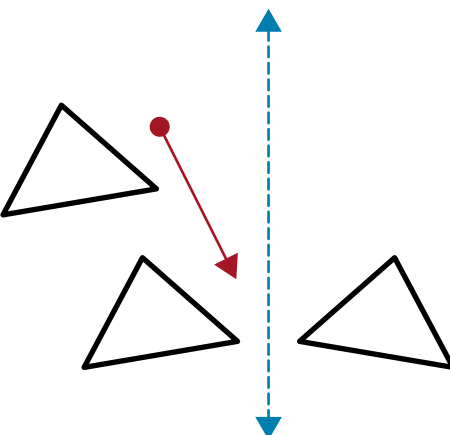

Definition

A **glide reflection** is a **composition of two transformations**: a **translation** followed by a **reflection** over a line **parallel to the direction of the translation**.

Key Points:

- It's a **rigid motion**, meaning it preserves **shape and size**.
- The reflection line must be **parallel** to the direction of the slide.
